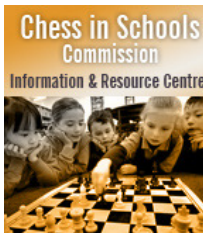

Education, the level of play of little champions was impressive for the professionals! The presence of two former world champions delighted the children, especially the captains of teams that have faced them in duo games. Vladimir Kramnik, World champion between 2000 and 2007, and Alexandra Kosteniuk, World champion in 2008, offered beautiful memories to all those budding players in a memorable exhibition match.
